

2022 Audition Information

If you are hoping to audition for the Vermont Symphony Orchestra's 2nd Trombone vacancy, please print out the application form on this website and mail it in with your resume and a \$25 deposit to hold your space. Your resume should clearly reflect your professional orchestral experience.

Due to time limitations, we may not be able to hear everyone who is interested in auditioning. If you are not selected to come to the audition, your deposit will be returned to you by mail; otherwise, you will get it back if and only if you actually take the audition. (You don't get it back even if you cancel ahead of time—this is our policy.)

If your application form and deposit check are not received in the office by August 15, we may not be able to include you in the audition; if not, you may be placed on a waiting list as appropriate. You will be notified after April 1 whether you are invited to take the audition.

At this point we are planning on hearing auditions from 9am to 5pm on Thursday, September 15, at the Elley-Long Center in Colchester, Vermont.
